USE OF FORCE JULY – SEPTEMBER 2022

The following statistics capture all use of force options exercised by all responding officers. During most incidents, more than one use of force option was used. The statistics refer to 17 incidents, for which 10 team and 9 individual reports were filed. For team reports, one report is filed for multiple officers. All incidents involved the execution of search warrants, subjects assaultive and/or armed, subjects suspected to be armed with weapons, or euthanizing injured animals.
