USE OF FORCE JULY–SEPTEMBER 2019

Firearm displayed	5	one incident involving male with mental health issues threatening self-harm; one incident responding to call of shots fired; one incident related to suspect with knife

Firearm discharged	4	one discharge of firearm related to active attacker with knife; remainder related to discharge of injured animals
CEW displayed	3	one incident involving male with mental health issues threatening self-harm and one incident involving assaultive male in stolen vehicle resisting arrest
CEW deployed	2	CEW was deployed by two officers in an attempt to stop active attacker
The above statistics refer to 15 incidents, for which 25 individual reports were filed (5 incidents involved multiple officers).
