USE OF FORCE JANUARY–MARCH 2019

The following statistics capture use of force options exercised by all responding officers. During most incidents, more than one use of force option was used. The statistics refer to 19 incidents, for which 16 individual and 5 team reports were filed. For team reports, one report is filed for multiple officers.
