USE OF FORCE JANUARY–MARCH 2020

The following statistics capture all use of force options exercised by all responding officers. During most incidents, more than one use of force option was used. The statistics refer to nine incidents, for which 1 team and 14 individual reports were filed. For team reports, one report is filed for multiple officers. With the exception of one call regarding an injured deer and one related to a dangerous driver, all incidents involved subjects assaultive and/or armed or suspected to be armed with weapons.
