USE OF FORCE JANUARY–MARCH 2021

The following statistics capture all use of force options exercised by all responding officers. During most incidents, more than one use of force option was used. The statistics refer to 20 incidents, for which 11 team and 15 individual reports were filed. For team reports, one report is filed for multiple officers. With the exception of two calls regarding an injured deer, all incidents involved subjects assaultive and/or armed or suspected to be armed with weapons.
