Caution should be exercised when interpreting these statistics. They represent a snapshot in time and are subject to change, as they relate to investigations that are ongoing. Through investigation, it may be determined that the classification must be recoded (for example, recoded from "Criminal Harassment" to "Harassing Phone Calls").

USE OF FORCE

The following statistics capture all use of force options exercised by all responding officers. During most incidents, more than one use of force option was used. The statistics refer to 16 incidents, for which 7 team and 12 individual reports were filed. For team reports, one report is filed for multiple officers. De-escalation was attempted in 12 reports. In the 7 reports where not attempted, de-escalation was either not possible due to immediate action being required or imminent threat; or not being applicable (dispatch of an animal). With the exception of one call regarding an injured deer, all incidents involved subjects assaultive and/or armed or suspected to be armed with weapons.
