Through investigation, it may be determined that the classification must be recoded (for example, recoded from “Criminal Harassment” to “Harassing Phone Calls”).

Additionally, the cyber incident which occurred at the beginning of January 2025 has impacted our ability to accurately determine statistics for the period of November 1, 2024, through to March 31, 2025. As a result, while we were able to generate some numbers, the data above is not necessarily an accurate representation of incidents during the affected time period.
