1. Policy Statement

The Kingston Police Service Board (the Board) is committed to ensuring that searches of premises are conducted with strict adherence to legal, constitutional, and case law requirements. It is the policy of the Board to direct the Chief of Police to establish and maintain procedures that ensure that searches of premises are conducted in a lawful, proportionate, and accountable manner.

2. Board Policy

Pursuant to *Ontario Regulation 392/23 - Adequate and Effective Policing (General)* it is the policy of the Kingston Police Service Board with respect to search of premises that the Chief of Police will:

- a) Establish and maintain written procedures on search of premises that require the compliance by members of the Police Service with the legal, constitutional, and case law requirements relating to the search of premises; and

- b) Ensure that officers and other members as appropriate are kept informed of changes in the law relating to search of premises.
