Caution should be exercised when interpreting these statistics. They represent a snapshot in time and are subject to change, as they relate to investigations that are ongoing. Through investigation, it may be determined that the classification must be recoded (for example, recoded from “Criminal Harassment” to “Harassing Phone Calls”).

Additionally, the cyber incident which occurred at the beginning of January 2025 has impacted our ability to accurately determine statistics for the period of November 1, 2024, through to March 31, 2025. As a result, while we were able to generate some numbers, the data above for the first quarter of 2025 is not necessarily an accurate representation of incidents during the affected time period.

USE OF FORCE

The following statistics capture all use of force options exercised by all responding officers. During most incidents, more than one use of force option was used. The statistics refer to 18 incidents, for which 13 team and 5 individual reports were filed. For team reports, one report is filed for multiple officers. De-escalation was attempted in 14 reports. In the 4 reports where not attempted, de-escalation was not used due to the officer having no interaction with the subject, immediate action being required, or the euthanasian of an animal). All incidents involved subjects who were assaultive and/or armed or suspected to be armed with weapons, or subject to the execution of a warrant.
