Caution should be exercised when interpreting these statistics. They represent a snapshot in time and are subject to change, as they relate to investigations that are ongoing. Through investigation, it may be determined that the classification must be recoded (for example, recoded from “Criminal Harassment” to “Harassing Phone Calls”).

USE OF FORCE

The following statistics capture all use of force options exercised by all responding officers. During most incidents, more than one use of force option was used. The statistics refer to 14 incidents, for which 9 team and 6 individual reports were filed. For team reports, one report is filed for multiple officers. De-escalation was attempted in 14 reports. In the 1 report where not attempted, de-escalation was not used due to the officer having no interaction with the subject. All incidents involved subjects who were assaultive and/or armed or suspected to be armed with weapons, or subject to the execution of a warrant.
